- 2. Recyclable (green) trash dumpsters, Thursday pickup. - 3. <u>Bulky Item / e-Waste pickups</u>. Homeowners are allowed up to two (2) **FREE** bulky item and e-waste pickups per year. Submit a bulky item pickup request online at ValleyVistaServices.com/Bulky-Item. Email an itemized list wvsbulky@myvvs.com or call 800-442-6454 to schedule bulky item pickups and reference account #100090. Bulky items are to be placed near the dumpster enclosures with a sign designating "Valley Vista Services." Please note that large bulky items needing more than two (2) people to lift will **not** be picked up.
- 4. Moving? Renovating? Temporary dumpster bins in different sizes from 3-yard to 40-yard capacity are available for rent from Valley Vista. Contact Valley Vista, 800-442-6454, www.valleyvistaservices.com/dumpster-rental, for a quote. To residents who are moving out or renovating: PLEASE do not fill up the onsite dumpsters which are for everyone's everyday trash. Your CHOA account will be assessed any extra charges incurred, and you will be fined.
- 5. Household Hazardous Waste (HHW). The following should NEVER be placed in any dumpster: antifreeze abrasive cleaners batteries fluorescent tubes/bulbs motor oil paint pesticides prescription drugs sharps/syringes/lancets transmission fluid. Homeowners must bring these items to HHW collection centers: 1071 N. Blue Gum St. in Anaheim or 17121 Nichols St. in Huntington Beach from 9am 3pm, Tuesday through Saturday (closed on major holidays and during rainy weather).
